Long Term Care Quadruple Aim for COVID-19 Response

- Sufficient and properly used PPE
- Readily available testing of staff and residents
- Stellar Infection Prevention
- Emergency Preparedness/Incident Command Mode

Stellar Infection Prevention

- ENGAGE THE MEDICAL DIRECTOR
 - Medical Director should strongly support the IP and their role and responsibilities
 - Regular rounds through the facility promoting infection control
 - Evaluate complex admissions and any resident with possible Covid-19 infection

Emergency Preparedness Mode

- Key to operationalizing everything else!
- Proxy for excellent leadership & management

Facility Leadership Team During the COVID-19 Pandemic

- Administrator
- Director of Nursing
- Medical Director
- Infection Preventionist
- Director of Staff Development

Role of the Administrator

- Must be the leader of the entire team
- Now is not the time to focus on admissions and discharges
- Now is the time to make sure that everyone is doing their job to battle the pandemic
- Focus on staff morale
- Assuring that everyone is apprised of their specific best practices
- Keep everyone focused



Infection Preventionist

- Leader of all infection control efforts
- Deputizing hand hygiene and PPE monitors
- Monitoring testing results
- Assuring Isolation is happening
- Contact tracing as needed



Medical Director

- Clinical leader in facility
- Must make tough decisions regarding facility admissions and discharges
- Provide direction to clinicians caring for facility residents
- Interacts with Director of Nursing
- Works closely with Consultant Pharmacist
- Provides leadership for QAPI program



Director of Nursing

- Responsible for nursing leadership in the facility
- Support for infection preventionist
- Assures appropriate staffing
- Works closely with administrator and medical director
