- Dual Special Need Plans (SNP)

State

- AB 1040
- SB 1008
- 1115 Waiver





What ACA Brought Us



Office of Duals

- Focus on coordinating Medicare and Medicaid
- Development of Payment Demos

Center for Medicare Medicaid Innovation (CMMI)

Funding for innovations





CA Duals Pilot v.1



- Awarded CMS Payment Demo
- 8 counties
- Mandated MediCal and Lock-in
- Six months Lock-in for Medicare
- Carve out In Home Support Services (IHSS) and ESRD





CA MOU Released 3/27/13



- 8 counties
- LA County capped at 200,000
- Carve out ESRD, IHSS, 1915 c Waivers (?Behavioral Health {BH})
- No Medicare Lock-in
- Separate statistics from Accountable Care
 Organization (ACO), Community Care Transitions
 Program





Operations of CAL MediConnect



- Begin no earlier than 10/1/13
- Notifications to beneficiaries 7/1/13
- Add Transportation, Dental and Vision
- Encourage additional Long Term Supports and Services (LTSS) benefits
